

# DANIEL POWTER



## INTERNATIONAL TIMELESS SINGER OF THE YEAR ( NORTH AMERICA )

Canadian artist Daniel Powter seems to have been born with melodies pouring out of his soul. Performing music since he was a child, he gradually focused on learning to write songs. He quickly found that music was his true passion, realising that it was the only thing he wanted to do. Throughout his youth, Daniel wrote and performed his songs to family, friends and anyone who would listen. Then, on a random ferry ride from Victoria to Vancouver it happened. He wrote a song that comes along rarely, like the total eclipse of the sun - A song that was instantly relatable to everyone who heard it, with a melody that once heard was never forgotten, and it continues to touch fans all over the world. That song was "Bad Day", Daniel Powter's first single on Warner Bros. Records.





"Bad Day" turned into a runaway hit around the world with over 25 million copies sold and continues to stream massively to this day. After its initial release, the song charted at #1 in over 40 countries around the world, including the Asian territories of Taiwan, Japan, China, Hong Kong, Korea, Indonesia, Singapore, Malaysia and the Philippines. "Bad Day" was #1 on the Billboard Hot 100 singles charts for five consecutive weeks. It was an unstoppable juggernaut that became and remains the largest-selling digital single in history around the world. Daniel was awarded numerous awards throughout the world for this achievement and for the massive success of his debut album. "Free Loop," another hit single from that album, also received massive airplay and sales throughout the world shortly thereafter.

In Japan, the album was the second-biggest-selling debut album ever from an international artist, selling well over 1.5 million copies. This success in Southeast Asia alone has over the years led to multiple sold-out shows and television performances throughout the region, including Japan, China, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Thailand, Singapore and Indonesia. Daniel was also a featured performer on the worldwide telecast of Live 8, featuring the very top artists throughout the world performing at eight different locations. Daniel performed before hundreds of thousands of fans and delivered a stellar performance in the shadow of Berlin's Brandenburg Gate. He has toured extensively throughout North America, Europe, Australia as well as in Asia to promote his multiple album releases.

In addition to "Bad Day" and "Free Loop," his early albums generated the hit songs "Best of Me," "Whole World Around," "Next Plane Home", "Jimmy Gets High," "Love You Lately," "Cupid," "Perfect for Me" and "Delicious."

In the spring of 2023, Daniel recorded and co-produced an EDM version of “Bad Day” with a top European EDM producer and DJ. The song was released in the summer of 2023 and achieved instant massive success, showing that Daniel’s talent is recognised across many musical genres. In fact, the song, as of August 2024 remains his #3 streaming song across his entire catalog. In early 2024 Daniel stunned Canadian audiences by performing a new rendition of “Bad Day” as a surprise, unannounced guest on the #1 Canadian show “Canada’s Got Talent”, creating a viral sensation.

Daniel is currently completing recording several new singles for his forthcoming album release scheduled for early 2025, one of which has already been identified as a possible theme for the 2028 Olympics in Los Angeles. We are preparing for a worldwide tour that will coincide with the new album release, which likely will commence in SE Asia after the Chinese New Year.
