



Born August 26th 1983 in Penang, she's considered the greatest squash player of all time. She holds records such as: World No.1 for 112 months and in that time retained the no. 1 ranking for 108 consecutive months, the longest reigning World no. 1 squash player. 8 times World Champion, 10 times Asian Champion alongside being considered one of Malaysia's most trusted personalities.

In July 2016, Nicol reached her 151st successive month in the top 10, almost 13 years - overtaking the previous record established by Men's player Peter Nicol in October 2006. She was recently crowned the greatest athlete of all time in World Games history.

Her next mission is to give back to the next generation. She launched in June 2022 her non profit organisation, the Nicol David Organisation with the mission of empowering girls and boy through sport and education. Established in Kuala Lumpur and providing after school programme that includes Squash and English tutoring to low and mid income children. Nicol is the Head Coach of the programme and her objective is to reach 5,000 children across Malaysia. "We believe everyone has the potential to be a champion; they just have to have the opportunity," says Nicol. "When the kids step into the court, I can see that they feel powerful, they feel confident."
