Another landmark event in his career was the "Laugh Malaysia" show at the Putra Stadium in Bukit Jalil, where he performed in front of a staggering 9,000 people. This event, one of the largest stand-up comedy shows in Asia, showcased his remarkable ability to hold and entertain a large audience with his humor and charisma.

Expanding his reach to digital platforms, Iskander launched his own online talk show series "What's Going On Malaysia". Featuring guests such as Tun Mahathir Mohamad amongst others, Harith's candid and humorous style of questioning allowed him to get the most out of his guests. This series further solidified his status as a prominent figure in entertainment, adapting his unique style of comedy to the digital era and reaching a broader, more technologically-savvy audience.

Currently Harith is working on a what he considers his 'tour de force' – "A Better Malaysia Project".

Having spent a life time focused on and studying Malaysian society (for comedy material) and growing weary of seeing how divided Malaysians have become over matters of politics, race and religion - Harith is now determined to 'give back' in the form of a vehicle by which he plans to 'stop the slide' and 'steady the course' by addressing issues that divide Malaysians in the effort of creating A Better Malaysia'
