Lara Maigue

Lara Maigue is an award-winning Filipino soprano and songwriter known for her versatility in musical genres, from opera and kundiman to jazz, Broadway and original compositions. A graduate of the University of the Philippines College of Music, majoring in Voice, she gained early recognition by winning the Aliw Awards for Best Female Classical Performer in 2017 and Best Female Crossover Performer in 2018. Her musical accomplishments also include winning Best Jazz Recording at the 2019 and 2023 Awit Awards, and her debut album earned the Pop Album of the Year at the 2020 Star Awards for Music.

Lara's talent has been praised internationally, with Grammy-winning soprano Sumi Jo commending her "supernatural high notes." She became an internet sensation in 2023 when her video singing Mozart's "Queen of the Night" aria garnered over 30 million views on Instagram. She has also performed for world leaders, including four Filipino Presidents and the U.S. President, and has toured internationally, completing sold-out Broadway concerts in Malaysia, Singapore, and Manila.

Lara's contributions extend beyond the stage. She is a finalist in prestigious songwriting competitions, and her work has been featured in major teleserye theme songs. In addition, she is a Save the Children Philippines Changemaker and raised significant funds for children's educational programs during the COVID-19 pandemic.



Currently, Lara divides her time between performing and managing her family's music school, the Mague Music Studio. In 2024, she received the Bagong Sibol (Emerging Artist) Award from the Philippine Leaf Awards, solidifying her status as one of the most sought-after performers in the Philippines and Asia.
